Eligibility Rules

Member-at-Large: Must be a member of JCGB with voting privileges.

Youth Representative: Must be a member of JCGB with voting privileges and must be below 30 years of age at the beginning of the term.

Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Director of Building Operations: Must have been a member of JCGB with voting privileges for minimum of 2 years.

President must have a minimum of 2 years experience on the Executive Committee.

All the **Board members** must have a minimum of 2 years of experience in Executive Committee.

Voting Privileges: Every individual over 18 years of age, who has been a General Member for at least 1 year, and who lives within the five states of Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont, Rhode Island and Maine, will have the voting privileges. Any family or individual over 18 years of age who

fills out a signed membership application form and lives within five states of Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont, Rhode Island or Maine will become a General Member. The membership period runs from January to December of following year and coincides with the term of the Executive Committee. Members joining in the middle of the term will have to renew the membership for the next period. Every General Member must fill out a membership form every two years.
